ANF, ANS, and BNS car types are also referred to as sleeping cars.

There are several designators for Diesel Rail Cars. For simplicity APN refers to any air conditioned equipment, BPD for any fan cooled equipment. The following trains have light meal, refreshment and beverage service:

Travel Warning - Southern Thailand

There are almost daily terrorist attacks in the far south including arson, bombings and shootings. Targets have included civilians and members of the security forces, government offices, tourist hotels, discotheques and bars, shops, marketplaces, supermarkets, schools, transport infrastructure and trains. Since 2004, over 3,500 people have been killed and several thousand more injured. Martial law remains in place in the provinces of Pattani, Yala, Narathiwat and in the Sadao district of Songkhla province. Security authorities can detain suspects without charge, censor the media, conduct searches and seize documents. The British Foreign Office and the United States Department of State recommend only essential travel should be made between Hat Yai Junction and Sungai Kolok. This does not affect travel via Padang Besar.

The railway does not require advance purchase of tickets and they may be purchased at any time prior to departure if available. It is advisable to purchase tickets in advance for first class and second class travel, as tickets may sell out before travel date. Normally third class tickets can be purchased on day of travel. During peak travel periods such as New Year's and the Songkran Festival (April) trains are often sold out and purchasing tickets as far in advance as possible is advised. Tickets may be purchased 60 days prior to travel.

Internet Ticketing (e-SRT)

The State Railway of Thailand offers train booking via their e-SRT internet site (http://www.thairailticket.com). Tickets may be purchased for all classes of travel from 2 hours to 60 days prior to train departure. The internet site is available in Thai and English languages and operates continuously (24 hours each day). Registration is not required to check train schedules, fares or seat availability. Special Express, Express and Rapid trains are available for on line booking in all class accomodations. There are no Eastern Line trains available on e-SRT.

Registration is free and is required to reserve seats and make payments. The registration process requires Thai citizens to enter their National Identification Number or passport number; citizens of other countries must provide their passport number. All tickets purchased using e-SRT must be paid for at the time of purchase using Mastercard, Visa or Bangkok Bank (BBL) debit card via the internet. The system allows booking four seats or sleeping car berths per transaction. The SRT imposes a 20 Baht booking fee per transaction and a 3% surcharge of the total amount for credit card purchases. When transaction is complete ticket(s) will be displayed as PDF file for downloading and printing.

Booking to stations in Laos and Malaysia are not available via internet. The SRT does not make all seats available for internet booking and if e-SRT shows no seats available, there may be seats available for booking at railway stations or through the 24 hour call center (1690). Changes or cancellations to tickets booked via e-SRT must be made at railway stations The same conditions shown the following page apply for e-SRT ticket changes, cancellations at refunds.

Telephone Booking

The State Railway of Thailand maintains a 24 hour Call Center for reservations, ticketing and information in the Thai and English languages. The Call Center is accessed by dialing 1690 from any telephone in Thailand. Reservations may be made up to 60 days prior to travel.

Fax and E-mail Booking

For reservations by e-mail (passenger-ser@railway.co.th) or via fax (0 2225 6068), provide the travel date, train number, departure time, class of travel, sleeper berth (upper or lower) if applicable, number of passengers, your name and e-mail address. The railway will send an e-mail confirmation and instructions for purchasing tickets at the railway station (It may be several days before a response is received from the railway). Tickets must be purchased by the time specified in the message or the reservations will be cancelled. Reservation requests via e-mail or fax may be made for travel 60 days in advance but must be submitted not later than 15 days prior to travel to allow processing. There is a 200 Baht surcharge for reserving tickets by e-mail or fax.

Purchasing Tickets on Trains

The State Railway of Thailand imposes a surcharge of 250 Baht for each ticket purchased on express trains and 100 Baht for other trains when a passenger boards at a station where tickets are available for purchase. The fee is not assessed for children, secondary school students in uniform, at stations without ticket agents or if tickets cannot be sold at a station due to technical issues. Any person discovered on a train without a valid ticket is assessed the same surcharges. The surcharges are added to the ticket price.

Travel Agencies

Tickets may also be purchased from travel agencies in Thailand who impose a surcharge for their services. Many travel agencies offer the advantage of advance reservations via the internet and accept credit and debit cards. Tickets may be delivered to a hotel, residence or picked up by the purchaser. Travel agencies have access to tickets 60 days prior to travel.

Combination Tickets

The SRT, travel agencies and some ferry or bus operators can offer combination rail - bus - ferry tickets. Ferry and bus operators may also issue tickets including bus or van transfers with the railway station.

Full refund of ticket cost is available for trains cancelled or seating of the same class not available due to overbooking, error by the railway or lack of passenger train equipment.

Refund of the air conditioning supplemental fee is granted if air conditioning fails to operate for 75% of the distance travelled. If the air conditioning fails to operate for 25% or less of the distance travelled no refund is provided.

Refund requests must be submitted on form provided and accompanied by the ticket. The request may be submitted at any railway station and must be submitted within one year of the date ticket was issued.

Discount Fares

Children less than 100 cm. (39 inches) height not requiring a seat ride for free.

Children between 100 cm. (39 inches) and 150 cm. (59 inches) travel at half regular fare (excluding supplemental fees).

Fare Calculation

The State Railway of Thailand calculates basic fares by multiplying the fare rate for class of travel times the distance travelled. In addition to the basic fare, supplemental fees assessed for:

- Travel on Special Express, Express and Rapid Trains.
- Air conditioned accommodations
- Occupancy of First and Second Class Day and Night Coach (sleeping cars).

Visit Thailand Rail Pass

The Visit Thailand Rail Pass for non-residents provides for 20 days of unlimited travel in second and third class accommodations.

- Type A (Red Pass) includes all supplemental fees and costs 3000 Baht for adults and 1500 Baht for children.
- Type B (Blue Pass) does not include supplemental fees and costs 1500 Baht for adults and 750 Baht for children.

A child is defined as over three but less than twelve years of age. No charge for children under four years of age not requiring separate seats. The rail pass does not guarantee a seat or berth, reservations are recommended. The pass is valid for unlimited travel within Thailand and to or from Tha Ne Laeng, Laos. Not valid for Malaysian travel.

Rail pass must be validated validated at a railway station before boarding the first train. Rail passes are valid until midnight on the last day (20th day). If journey begins before midnight on the last day, the pass is valid to destination.

Passes must be purchased in Thailand at Hua Lamphong Station Advance Booking Office in Bangkok. Travel agents do not offer the rail pass. Passport must be presented at time of purchase for identification and proof of foreign residency.

Luggage (Baggage)

On board allowance is one large suitcase or similar item and one small carry on bag per passenger. Additional baggage will be transported in the freight carriage (baggage car) and subject to a charge. The State Railway of Thailand does not offer checked baggage (luggage) service. There is a fee based parcel service available. Weight limits for carry on baggage:

Excess baggage, bicycles, motor cycles, golf clubs and other large items must be carried in the freight carriage (baggage car) and will be charged a charge. After purchasing seat ticket, a cargo ticket must be purchased for these items. Part of the cargo ticket is attached to the item and part to the passenger ticket. To claim your item, the passenger ticket and cargo ticket must be presented. Check with the railway to determine which trains accept large items such as bicycles and motorcycles. The railway permits passengers to bring folding type bicycles on board without charge provided the bicycle will be placed overhead or under seat and will not obstruct the aisle.

Prohibited Items:

- magnetized, flammable, corrosive, oxidizing or explosive items.
- pressurized gasses.
- weapons, munitions and fireworks.
- strong smelling materials or foods.

Animals are prohibited in air conditioned cars. They may be carried in non-air conditioned cars provided they are properly caged. Caged animals may be transported in baggage car for a minimum fee of 50 Baht. "Fierce dogs" may not be transported.

Principal railway stations offer secure rooms where baggage (luggage) may be stored for a nominal fee. The attendant will provide a receipt which is presented to claim items.

Food Service

Restaurant cars are provided on express and rapid trains as indicated in the timetable. These cars are air conditioned on Trains 1, 2, 35 and 36, fan colled on other trains. Occupants of sleeping cars have option to eat at their seats or in the restuarant cars. Meal prices range from 150 Baht to 400 Baht. Food may be purchased from vendors at many stations.

On Diesel Rail Cars Second class passengers are served light meals (a rice dish), snacks and beverages at their seats. The cost is included with the fare. Third class passengers may by food on board or from vendors at station stops.

Day and Night Coaches (Sleeping Cars)

First Class cars are air conditioned and have private compartments with two sleeping berths at night and sitting area during the day. There are wash basins in each compartment and a toilet with shower in each car.

Second Class cars may be air conditioned or fan cooled as indicated in the timetable. They feature semi-private berths with curtains for privacy at night and a sitting area during the day. Second Class JR-West cars have private compartments.

Pillows, sheets and blankets are provided. Car attendents will convert day seating to night berths and back to day seating in the morning.
